

ATI Fees for Sponsor Certification Sessions (as of 3/01/20)

Standard fee is set at \$100 US per certification session in the United States. The fee for each country in which ATI has members is determined using the World Bank Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) Conversion Factor. We are using the PPP conversion factor January 2020 for the next two (2) years; at that time the fee and country equivalents will updated by the Board.

ATI Sponsors visiting countries other than their home will charge the rate for the country in which the ATI certification session takes place.

The fee is paid directly to the ATI Sponsor.

Except for candidates attending the Pre-Day at the ATI conference, where it is combined with the conference fee. In this case it is 75% of the standard fee of the country in which the conference is being held.

Each ATI Sponsor is obligated to charge the appropriate fee for the certification session. There is no option of reducing or waiving the fee; however, they may choose to donate the charged fee to ATI in lieu of financial gain.
